




DOWNLOADING EBSCO EBOOKS TO DESKTOPS & MOBILE DEVICES

Please note: These instructions assume that the user has already created an EBSCOhost account and has downloaded Adobe Digital Editions (if using a desktop/laptop) or downloaded the appropriate app for their mobile device.

Downloading EBSCO ebooks to a pc or laptop
