## ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

The Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences was established in 1972 with the reorganization of UT Southwestern as a medical center with three components: the medical school, graduate school, and a health professions school. The graduate programs were initially established as part

of the Southwestern Medical School's teaching program in the basic sciences. The earliest graduate degree was received in 1947, before Southwestern Medical School was affiliated with the University of Texas. According to the 1973-1974 graduate school bulletin, "The goal of the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences at the University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas is to provide the outstanding student with the opportunity and the stimulus to investigate in depth and to solve contemporary problems in the biological, physical and behavioral sciences." The graduate school has two Divisions: Basic Science and Clinical Science. These Divisions include the following specific areas of graduate studies: Biological Chemistry, Biomedical Engineering, Cancer Biology, Cell Regulation, Clinical Psychology, Clinical Sciences, Genetics and Development, Immunology, Integrative Biology, Molecular Biophysics, Molecular Microbiology, and Neuroscience. The Medical Scientist Training Program is a collaborative program of the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences and Southwestern Medical School in which students receive a combined M.D./Ph.D. degree.

## **SCOPE AND CONTENT**

The records document graduate school operations and academic programs, including program informational booklets, memos, newsletters, and commencement programs. A record of interest is a 1975 preliminary report examining the role and scope of the graduate school. Commencement programs for the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences classes of 1973 to 2008 are filed in the Southwestern Medical School Records collection.
