ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

The Office of News and Publications (before 1993 called the Office of Medical Information; the name changed to University News Bureau in September 2011; the office is now known as Communications, Marketing, and Public Affairs) was the UT Southwestern department responsible for (1) relations with the media and (2) preparation and distribution of the campus newspaper *Center Times*, *Southwestern Medicine* annual report, and other campus publications. The staff included a photographer who recorded notable campus events, with many of the photos being used in campus publications.
